

**REGULAR MEETING  
CITY COUNCIL, YORK, NEBRASKA  
JULY 7, 2011**

A meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of York, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:00 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers.

The President of the Council announced that the Open Meetings Act is posted on the East wall of the Council Chambers.

Present were: Leggett, Brink, Redfern, Toms, Wolfe, Obermier, Mogul and North. Absent: None. Also present were the City Clerk, City Administrator and Director of Public Works.

ORDINANCE NO. 2052

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF YORK, NEBRASKA TO REPEAL SECTION 23-14 OF THE YORK CITY CODE AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

Councilmember Toms moved and Councilmember Redfern seconded that the Statutory Rule requiring reading on three different days of Ordinance No. 2052 be suspended.
