

**REGULAR MEETING

**APPROVE SPECIAL DESIGNATED PERMIT APPLICATION**

Matt Leif was present in support of the application filed by the Knights of Columbus to sell alcoholic beverages on August 1, 2008 and August 2, 2008 for the York County Fair Public Beer Garden and Karaoke. He advised that the Knights have been handing this event since 1997 and that they have had no trouble with minors – that eight of their members have taken alcohol training through the York Police Department. He advised that the Friday night event will be held in the center field of the grandstand and that Saturday night will be under the tent.

Councilmember Redfield moved and Councilmember Mogul seconded that an application filed by the Knights of Columbus to sell alcoholic beverages at the York County Fairgrounds on August 1, 2008 and August 2, 2008 for a York County Fair Public Beer Garden Music Concert and Karaoke be approved.
