

**REGULAR MEETING  
CITY COUNCIL, YORK, NEBRASKA  
AUGUST 5, 2010**

A meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of York, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:00 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers.

The Mayor announced that the Open Meetings Act is posted on the East wall of the Council Chambers.

Present were: Redfern, Toms, Wolfe, Obermier, Mogul, North and Leggett. . Absent: Brink. Also present were the City Clerk, and City Administrator.

Notice of this meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the York News Times on August 2, 2010, the City's designated method for giving notice, a copy of the proof of publication being attached to these Minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to the Mayor and all members of the City Council and a copy of their acknowledgment and receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these Minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and City Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

**CITY ADMINISTRATOR REPORT**

The City Administrator reported that the Liquor Control Commission had reversed its decision and has issued a Class C Liquor License to the Finish Line.

recommend approval of special designated permit applications filed by KW's Concessions, Inc. to: 1) sell alcoholic beverages in the Cornerstone Event Center on August 21, 2010 for a wedding reception; 2) sell alcoholic beverages in the Cornerstone Event Center on August 28, 2010 for a wedding reception; and 3) sell alcoholic beverages in a beer garden on the York County Fairgrounds on September 17, 2010 (rain date September 18, 2010) for the annual figure 8 races.
