The sponsor agrees that if granted a permit to do said work, the following stipulations shall govern:

1. This application shall have been approved prior to sponsor beginning any operations as requested herein.
2. Sponsor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of York, its officers and employees from all liability, judgment, costs, expenses, and claims growing out of damages, or alleged damages of any nature whatsoever to any person, property, or third party arising out of the performance or non-performance of said work.
3. No vehicles, equipment, or materials are to be parked or stored within park, except during times working the project program.
4. This permit shall be subject to any laws now in effect, or any laws which may be hereafter enacted, and all applicable rules and regulations of local, state, and federal agencies.
5. The sponsor agrees to give the City of York 48 hours notice of intention to start operations. Notification shall be given to the Director of Public Works, whose address is P.O. Box 507, York, NE 68467, and whose phone number is 402-363-2600.
6. The sponsor shall carry on the work as required and authorized by this agreement with serious regard to the safety of the public, adjacent property owners, and volunteers or employees of the sponsor.
7. The sponsor acknowledges that all personnel involved in this project are initiators and volunteers directed by the sponsor and that the sponsor accepts full responsibility for any injuries or damages sustained by or caused by such personnel. The sponsor acknowledges that they or their volunteers are in no way considered employees of the City of York.

In consideration of the above, the sponsor and the City of York further agree to the following terms and conditions of this agreement:

Sponsor's Additional Responsibility:

- To perform the work specified in a satisfactory, safe and professional manner in accordance with good construction practices.
- To provide adult supervision at the work site when volunteers or employees are 15 years of age or younger.
- To obtain required supplies and materials as may be needed from the Parks and Recreation Department to carry out this agreement during regular business hours.
- All unused materials and supplies furnished by the Department shall be returned to the Department

The City of York reserves the right to terminate when, in the sole judgement of the City of York, it is found that the sponsor has not met the terms and conditions of this agreement.
