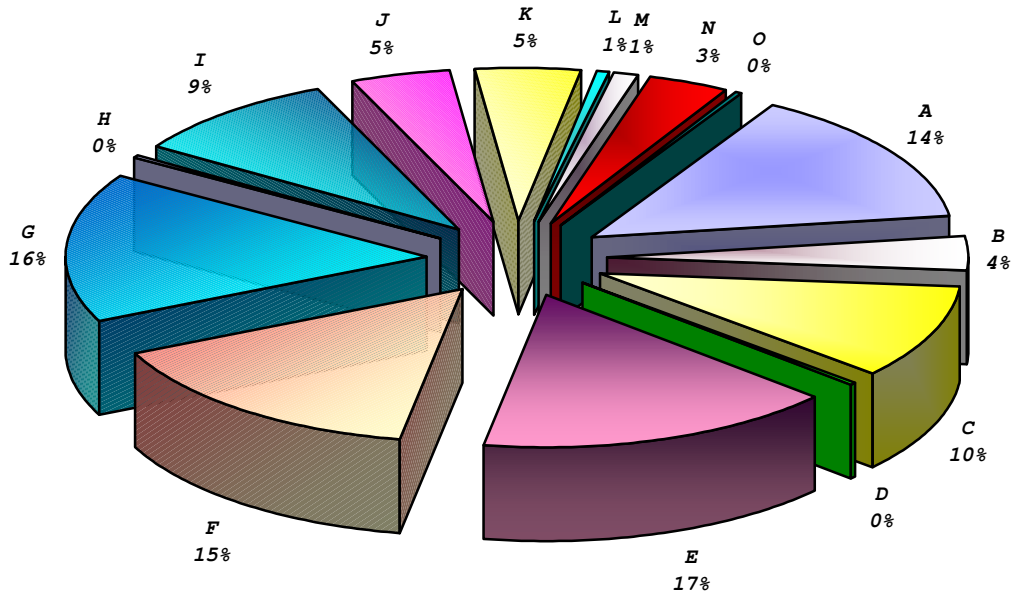


2006 ARRESTS



The above chart shows the largest percentage of arrests dealt with theft, liquor offenses, assaults, warrants, criminal mischief, and driving under suspension/revocation. All but two areas show decreases for 2006, that being A - Assaults, increase of 5.6% and M - Curfew violations with an increase of 200%. Notable areas of decrease were B - Driving under the influence at 37.5%, C - Driving under suspension/revocation at 23.5%, D - Criminal trespass at 92.9%, F - On warrants at 24.5%, G - Minor in possession at 30%, J - Drug violations at 45.5%, and N - Other at 66.7%.

The breakdown of the pie chart is as follows:

A	- Assaults/domestic abuse assaults/sexual assault/sexual assault of minor	38
B	- Driving under the influence (alcohol/drugs)	10
C	- Driving under suspension/revocation	26
D	- Criminal Trespass	1
E	- Theft/possession of stolen property/forgery/burglary	43
F	- On warrants	40
G	- Minor in possession/procuring/open alcohol container in vehicle and/or public property/minor attempting to purchase	42
H	- Harassment/stalking	1
I	- Criminal mischief	25
J	- Drug Violations (MJ/paraphernalia/distribute/manufacture/methamphetamines, etc)	12
K	- Disorderly conduct/disturbing the peace	12
L	- Child abuse/neglect	2
M	- Curfew violations	3
N	- Other (violation protection order/carrying concealed weapon/false reporting/ contributing/violation probation, etc.)	9
O	- Tobacco use by minor	1
