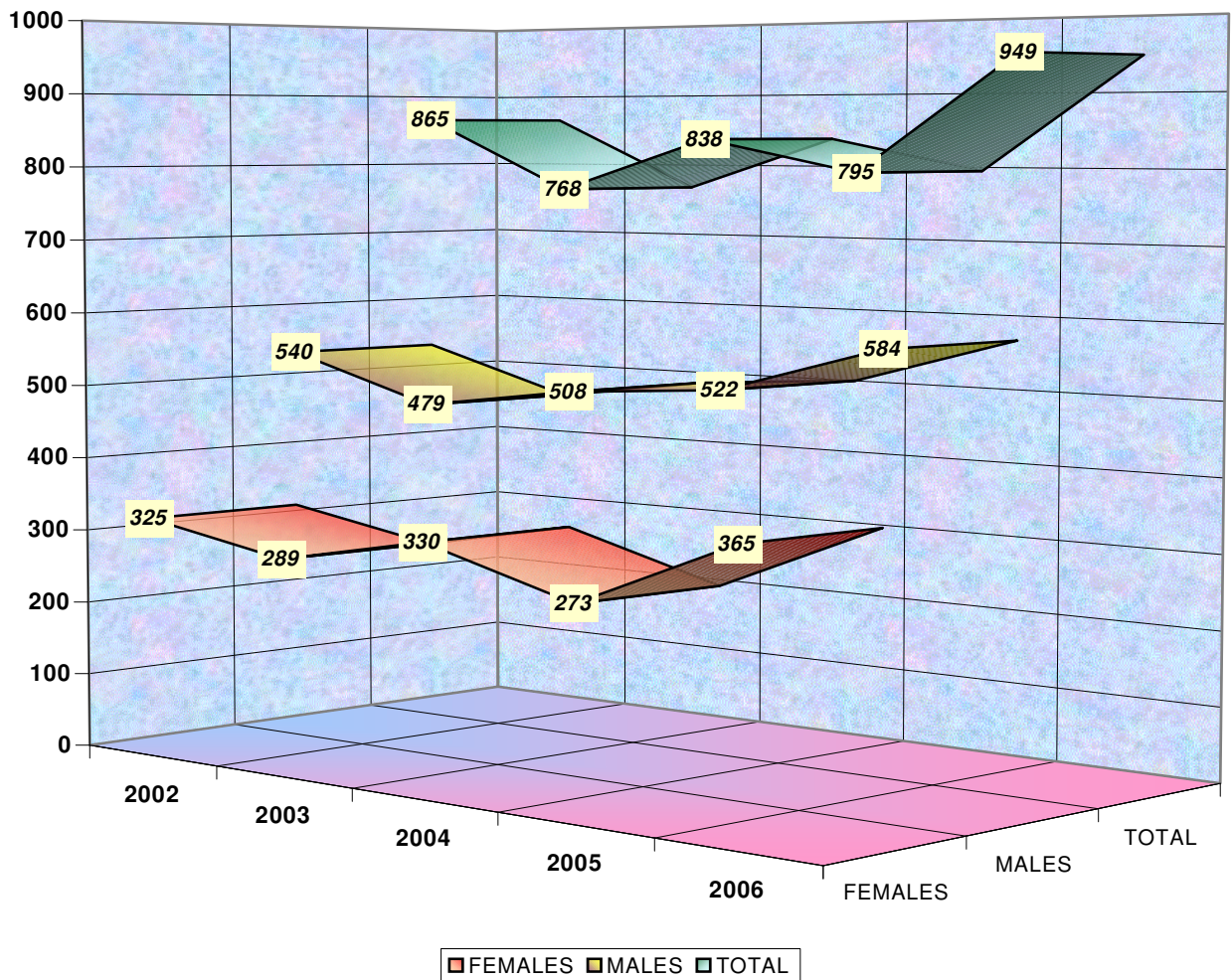


# JUVENILE CONTACTS 2006



Total juvenile contacts for 2006 showed an increase from 2005 of 19.4%. As shown on the following pie chart, the year of 2006 saw increases in many areas. The most notable were A - Theft at 38.7% (31 in 2005 to 43 in 2006), B - Criminal Mischief at 29.6% (27 in 2005 to 35 in 2006), D - Assaults at 67.4% (46 in 2005 to 77 in 2006), Victims of Child Abuse and etc. at 45% (114 in 2005 to 159 in 2006), F - Victims of Assault, etc. at 111% (42 in 2005 to 89 in 2006), G - Victim of Thefts/Criminal Mischief at 48.5% (33 in 2005 to 49 in 2006), M - Runaway at 75% (36 in 2005 to 63 in 2006), O - Domestic Related at 37% (46 in 2005 to 63 in 2006), and P - Curfew Violations at 29.6% (27 in 2005 to 35 in 2006).

The larger areas of decrease shown on the following pie chart for 2006 were C - Alcohol related at 31.3% (32 in 2005 to 22 in 2006) and C - Criminal Trespass at 54.5% (33 in 2005 to 15 in 2006).

The ratio of males to females was 584 males at 62% to 365 females at 38%. 2006 shows an increase in male contacts of 11.9% and an increase of 33.7% for females.
